

2019 CDBF Team City Information

"Team City" refers to the area of the festival grounds set aside for race teams to use as their home base for the day. Many teams bring their own tents for shade, chairs, coolers with water and sports drinks, grills, Frisbees, and other things to help them pass the time while they wait to race. Team City will be divided up into individual team areas that will be randomly assigned to the teams. The areas are on grass and are large enough to place a 15'x15' tent. Tents are not provided by CDBF, **you must bring your own tent and secure it without any ground penetration** (see rules below).

Teams will be assigned areas by random selection. The Team City address for your team can be found in the Database section of the Yahoo group. Although your Team City address may be on the sides or ends of Team City, there will not be any additional room for you to take up more than your designated 15'x15' area.

Team City Rules

1) Staking or penetrating the ground in Team City for any reason is not permitted. Teams found violating this rule will be assessed a **10 second penalty** for each of their races run after the violation is discovered. The penetration penalty does not apply when done by the CDBF official tent vendor. 2) Teams erecting a structure must print and sign a waiver, found at http://www.cdbf.org/uploads/1/1/9/5/119523304/2019_cdbf_teamcity_agreement.pdf 3) Beer, other alcoholic beverages, or marijuana are not permitted in Team City. Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs in Team City is reason to disqualify the team from subsequent race participation and eviction from Team City. 4) Sales or free distribution of promotional items, products, or services are not permitted in Team City. Persons involved in such activity will be ejected from the festival and the park. In addition, if a team, sponsor of a team, or occupants of Team City space are found violating this "no sales or distribution rule", the offending team will be assessed a **10 second penalty** in each of their races run after the violation is discovered. 5) Team or sponsor banner can only be hang within team tent. Banners hang outside of team tent will be assessed a **10 second penalty** 6) Propane or charcoal grills are not permitted. Teams found violating this rule will be assessed a **10 second penalty** for each of their races run after the violation is discovered.

Official Festival Tent Vendor

Your team may set up and secure (without any ground penetration) your own tent, or you may order one from our official tent vendor. For logistical reasons, no other tent vendors will be allowed onto the festival grounds.

Arriving at Team City

Each team may only bring **two** vehicles onto the festival grounds for the purpose of dropping off equipment. Each team will be given two 15-minute site access passes that allow those vehicles onto restricted streets.

For equipment drop-off, use the following procedure:

- 1) Take Sheridan Blvd to 26th. 2) Head East on 26th to Xavier Street. 3) Turn right and head south on Xavier to W. Byron. 4) Turn left onto W. Byron Street and drop off your equipment at Team City drop off sign. Park next to the barrier and unload there. It is easier and faster if other teammates are already there waiting to help carry stuff to your area. Please unload as quickly as possible to avoid traffic backups. 5) Continue east to Vrain and turn left to exit the festival area.

The drop-off map for the festival will be mailed to you prior to the festival dates.

Parking

Please car-pool as much as possible! Parking is available at Sports Authority Field at \$5 per car. Free shuttle will be provided to take you from the parking lot to Sloan's Lake Park.

- Entire team meets and parks at the Sports Authority Field parking lots.
- All equipment/tents/coolers/etc are loaded into the two vehicles that have site access passes.
- The team rides the shuttle to Sloan's Lake and waits at the drop-off point for the vehicles.
- The two vehicles are driven to the lake, taking the designated route (posted later) to the drop-off point.
- All equipment is unloaded quickly.
- The drivers return to Sports Authority to park and ride the shuttle to meet their team.
